Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Richbourg Road, which iron pin is 1718.4 feet from the intersection of Wade Hampton Boulevard (U.S. Highway No. 29) and Richbourg Road, and running thence S. 68-23 W. 220.0 feet to an Iron pin; thence S. 18-57 E. 173.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-37 E. 200.0 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Richbourg Road; thence along the southwestern side of Richbourg Road, N. 9-08 W. 92.0 feet; thence continuing along the southwestern side of said road, N. 16-45 W. 95.0 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.
