(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pres-
ents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CHARLIE THOMAS WHEELER, JR., is heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL my undivided interest, the same being an undivided eight-ninths (8/9ths) interest, in and to all that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the Southeast side of Brockdale Avenue in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 7, of Block "D" on plat of Fair Heights, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, October, 1924, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "F", pages 256 and 257, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Brookdale Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7 of Block "D" and running thence with the line of Lot 6, S. 58-40 E., 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 31-20 W., 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 8 of Block "D" N. 58-40 W., 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Brookdale Avenue; thence with the Southeast side of Brookdale Avenue, N. 31-20 E., 50 feet to the beginning corner.

Bishop, Vincie Bishop Shelton and Clara Bishop Ziemer by their deed dated September 26, 1948, recorded in Deed Book 362, page 36, RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., conveyed their int4rest to the Grantor; and thereafter Inez Bishop Mantooth conveyed her interest in this property to the Grantor, on January 25, 1955, said deed of record in said RMC Office in Deed Book 517, page 54. E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, is conveying to the Grantee by separate deed the interest of Gerald Leon Bishop.
