ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as LOT NO. 15 in Subdivision known as Edgewood, as shown on plat of Judson Mills Property, said lot has a frontage on Piedmont Avenue of 60 feet and a depth of 150 feet to the line of the Piedmont & Northern Railway Company.
