and subject to mortgage indebtedness of \$5200.00

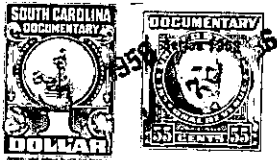

Austin lands according to plat made by E. S. Garv, November 25, 1927, said plat being recorded in Plat Book FF at Pages 6 and 7, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the Pelzer-Fork Shoals Road and running thence S. 4-3/4 E. 1421 feet to a stake in road at corner of Tracts Nos. 1, 3 and 4 of said John M.
