It is understood and agreed that the described property, along with other parcels on South Tyger River, is to be used by the Commission of Public Works for a water shed and reservoir for the City of Greer. The seller herein, as long as he owns the adjoining tract from which the above parcel is conveyed, or the subsequent owners of the same, shall have the following rights and privileges, but subject to the restrictions set forth.

- 1. To pasture to the water line, or to cultivate crops to the high water mark in flood season; to withdraw water for irrigation purposes when the same is available, subject to State laws and regulations.
- 2. To fish in the waters of the reservoir, subject to the laws of the State and the rules of the S.C. Fish and Game Commission and the rules of the Commission of Public Works.
