Rikard, reserving unto myself a life estate, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville in the sub-division known as New Hope about two miles from Greenville County Court House, and near Monaghan Mills, designated as Lot No. 15 on plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 409, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having a frontage of 60 feet on Fortner Street, and such metes and bounds as shown by said plat, being the same property conveyed to W. L. Altom by deed dated November 28, 1919, recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 53, page 227. The said W. L.
