Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Alice Howard surviving Executrix under the will of W. G. Howard, deceased in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 (\$1.00) and partition of real estate DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary Howard Barbare, her heirs and assigns, ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in Oneal Township containing 46.10 acres more or less known and designated as Tract No. 1 of the property of W. G. Howard Estate and having the following metes and bounds according to survey and plat made October, 1955 by Terry T. Dill, said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

BEGINNING at a point in the intersection of the Locust-Tigerville Highway and Bailey Road and running thence along the center of said said Locust-Tigerville Highway S. 35 W. 275 feet; thence still with said highway S. 32-10 W. 200 feet; thence still with said highway S. 24-50 W. 555 feet to point in center of said highway; thence N. 64-45 W. 468 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Roe property S. 46-35 W. 955 feet to pin; thence with line of Neves property N. 41-10 W. 934 feet to iron pin; thence with line of Tract No. 2 N. 48-36 E. 1762 feet to a point in center of Bailey Road; thence along center of said road S. 68-36 E. 200 feet and still with said road S. 62-46 E. 200 feet; thence still with said road S. 55-28 E. 400 feet; thence still with said road S. 60 E. 232 feet to the beginning corner.

BEING a portion of the tract of land owned by W. G. Howard at the time of his death and this deed is made in accordance with the authority vested in me under the terms of the Will of the said W. G. Howard which is of record in the Probate Office, Greenville, S. C. in Apartment 417, File 20. By the acceptance of this deed the Grantee herein agrees to a partition and division at this time and in this manner of the real estate referred to in said Will rather than have all of said real estate conveyed to the grantee and the other devisees named in said Will, as tenants in common.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anyway incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
