ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with all the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing one acre more or less and being part of tract no. 9, sold by Lady B. Drummond to Hattie Howard and having, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Greenville-Hendersonville Highway (also known as Highway No. 25) on the South side of said Highway and running thence with the said Highway nearly East 100 feet to an iron pin; thence nearly South 125 feet to an iron pin; thence nearly West 152 feet to a White Oak; thence nearly North 125 feet to an iron pin the beginning corner.
