all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situated and lying on Jamesson's Mill Creek, waters of South Pacolet river, known as Lot No. 4 of E.V. Lockhart's land division.

Beginning at double poplars on L.C. Lockhart's line, Pearl Robertson corner runs with branch near North to head of branch and straight on to Oak Grove Road on west side of church. Joins church lot of land, Thence; with said road near west to a large gulley, A.J.
