ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 471 of a subdivision known as Section "D", of Englewood Estates, as shown by a Plat thereof, dated February, 1955, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "BB", at Page 177.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Burmaster Drive at joint front corners of Lots No. 470 and 471 and running thence along the line of said Lot No. 470, N. 3-15 E. 272 feet to iron pin; thence N. 88-0 W. 97.1 feet to iron pin at Duke Power Company right-of-way; thence along the Duke Power Company right-of-way, S. 7-38 W. 269.4 feet to iron pin on Burmaster Drive; thence running with the said Burmaster Drive, S. 86-43 E. 120 feet to iron pin at point of beginning.

THAT the lands shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any negro or person of African descent; no residence to cost less than Eight Thousand Five Hundred (\$8,500.00) Dollars; shall be erected on said lots; no residence shall be erected on said lot nearer than fifty (50) feet to the front line; no residence shall be built on any lot unless said lot has fifty (50) feet, or more, frontage; no outside toilets permitted and sewage to be disposed of by approved septic tanks.

THIS deed is subject to any right-of-ways now existing.
