

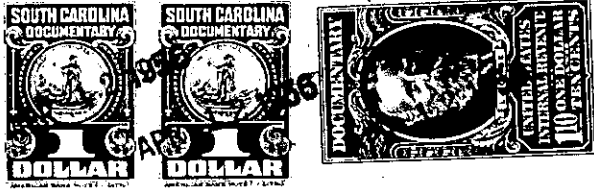

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said ... Jim McCullough, Simeon McCullough and
Will Pepper as Deacons and Trustees of St. Matthews Church and their successors
in office, forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina containing one and two hundredths (1.02) acres, more
or less.

Adjoining lands of myself, St. Matthews Church and possibly others.

Having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a point
in Greenville road, joint corner of St. Matthews Church and Jim McCullough, thence
along line of Jim McCullough, (Lot No. 2), S. 77½ W. 160 feet to joint corner of
Lots 2 and 6; thence along line of Lot No. 6, N. 28-50 W. 85 feet to joint corner
of Lots 6 and 5; thence along line of Lot No. 6, S. 77½ W. 160 feet to joint corner
