All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, containing 61½ acres more or less, bounded by property now or formerly of R. B. Arnold, D. P. Ridgeway, James A. Scott, J. A. Traynham and W. M. Ridgeway, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone in a public road and running thence N. 67-30 E. 3.64 chains to a stone; thence S. 27-45 E. 8.10 chains to a stone; thence N. 46-45 E. 9.10 chains to a stone; thence S. 48-45 E. 22.15 chains to a stone; thence S. 52 W. 24.45 chains to a stone on the western side of Little Horse Creek; thence N. 35 W. 3.46 chains to a corner in this creek; thence up the meanderings of Little Horse Creek to a corner in the creek at the bridge; thence up the public road to the beginning corner.

PARCEL NO. 2

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, on Little Horse Creek, containing 38½ acres more or less bounded by property now or formerly of J. E. Knight, Sr., Mr. Bagwell and others, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a corner in Little Horse Creek, and running thence N. 1 E. 120 chains to a stone; thence N. 65 E. 30.35 chains to a stone; thence S. 25-40 E. 14.55 chains to a stone; thence S. 46-45 W. 9.10 chains to a stone; thence N. 25-55 W. 8.10 chains to a stone; thence N. 67-35 W. 3.61 chains to a stone in public road; thence down said road to a corner at the bridge over a creek; thence up the meanderings of Little Horse Creek to the beginning corner.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 4 acres more or less, adjoining parcel No. 2 described above, situate, lying
