heirs and assigns forever; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations above referred to.

AND Christ Church Cemetery does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend the said premises to the said George R. Morgan and Mildred D. Morgan , heirs and assigns against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations herein contained.
