for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Harriett S. Baker and Freddie L. Baker, all the right, title and
interest of the minor Defendants, Jean Andrea Harleman and Sara Margaret
Harleman, the same being an undivided two-thirds interest in and to the
following described property:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing
3.5 acres, more or less, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Western side of U. S. Highway No. 25, and
running thence along said Highway N. 52-30 E. 350 feet to an iron pin;
thence N. 63-00 W. 875 feet more or less to a point; thence along a new
line approximately S. 37-30 E. 768 feet, more or less, to the point of be-
ginning."

The consideration for the above conveyance is \$233.34 and said amount
was paid direct to L. G. Harleman by the purchasers in accordance with the
