all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina Containing Twenty-six Acres, more or less, and bounded by land of Grantor, Bunyan Turner, W.C. Bramlett, and Clark and having the following Metes and Bounds:
