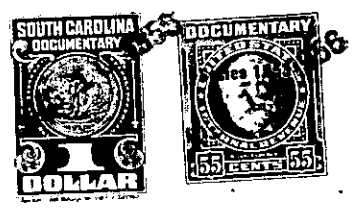

hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto  
ALMEDA R. CAMERON, her heirs and assigns forever

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate and being in Saluda Town-  
ship and being known as Tract Seventeen (17) in Section "C" of CAROLINA LAKE COLONY  
DEVEKIOMENT as shown on Plat made by J. Mac Richardson and Howard B. Miller, Reg-  
istered Land Surveyors, recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Convey-  
ance for Greenville County in Plat Book Y at Pages 126 and 127.

This conveyance is made subject to the Restrictions and Conditions applicale to
