That Mary Lord Harrill in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand, Eight Hundred and No/100 - (\$2,800.00) DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jessie Baker, her heirs and assigns forever.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the West side of Lindburg Street, in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 of Block D, as shown on a plat of the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineer, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 63, 64, and 65 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Lindburg Street at joint front corner of Lots No. 1 and 2, of Block D, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 1, S. 87-26 W. 124.86 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 31, N. 2-34 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 3, N. 87-26 E. 124.90 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Lindburg Street; thence with the West side of Lindburg Street, S. 2-30 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same conveyed to me By James R. Hendrix by deed dated July 3rd, 1943, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 254, at page 391.
