

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That SAM WALKER

its Successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Glassy Mountain Township, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 120 acres, more or less, being composed of two tracts and having the following description:

TRACT NO. 1: contains 80 acres, more or less, and is described as follows: BEGINNING on a beech tree, thence a continuation of the line between Angeline Burrell and James Lindsey to the old line; thence continuing with old line to Long Branch; thence a continued line with M. D. Howard and Peter Gosnell to a black oak; thence to a spanish oak; thence to a chestnut; thence to the beginning corner.

TRACT NO. 2: containing 40 acres, more or less, adjoining the above described tract along Long Branch being bounded by the North by Long Branch and the said 80 acre tract; on the East by lands now or formerly of the Saluda Land & Lumber Company; on the South by lands of Rufus Plumley and on the West by lands now or formerly of W. T. Lindsey.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of Theron E. Barton, et al, dated August 28, 1951, recorded in the RMC. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 441, at Page 234.

It is my intent by this deed to convey to The City of Greenville all my interest in the above described property and also any and all interest to any other property that I may now own including any interest that I might hereafter acquire in any property lying within the North Saluda River Watershed, being acquired by The City of Greenville, S. C.

ALSO all interest which the Grantor has in and to any lands lying within the boundaries of any road or street, adjacent to, bounding or running through the above described property.
