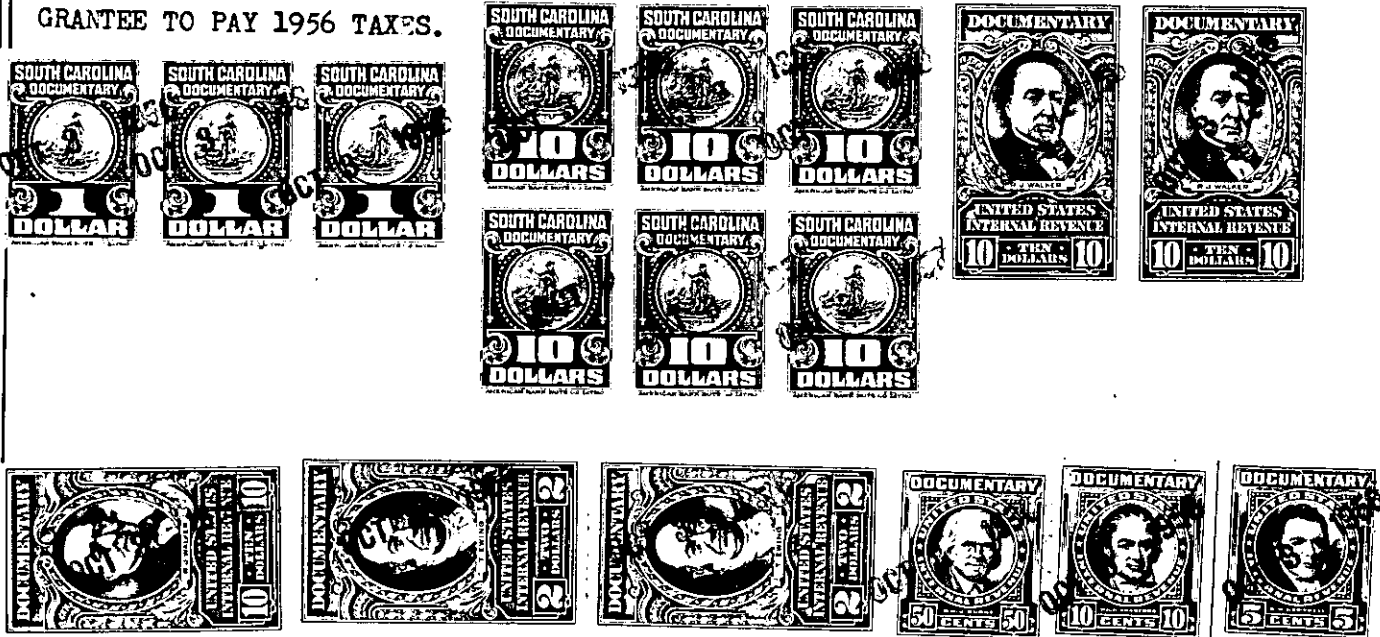


All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, on the Overbrook Road and Halsom Road in the Overbrook area and being the Northern and Eastern portion of Lot No. 46 as shown on plat of Overbrook recorded in Plat Book E at page 252, and likewise being a portion of said land conveyed to Allen M. Vaughn by Mary L. Bell and Margaret J. Bell and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northeastern side of Overbrook road at a point 66 feet Northeast of the joint corner of Lots Nos. 45 and 46, and running thence along Overbrook Road, N. 61-49 E. 34 feet; thence N. 41-24 E. 32 feet to another corner; thence N. 13-37 E. 26.2 feet to pin; thence N. 12-14 E. 21 feet to corner of Halsom Road; thence along Halsom Road, N. 29-19 W. 50 feet to corner; thence N. 42-13 W. 30 feet to corner; thence N. 65-55 W. 50 feet to corner; thence N. 70-20 W. 50 feet to corner; thence N. 40-13 W. 30 feet to corner of Lot No. 4; thence along lines of Lots No. 45 and 46; S. 20-54 E. 29 feet to corner; thence leaving this joint line and running N. 60-1 W. 30 feet to a new corner; thence N. 61-49 E. 16 feet to another new corner; thence S. 20-54 W. approximately 150 feet to the beginning corner.
