That MARION L. DICKSON in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY AND NO/100- - - - -DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage hereinbelow referred to; to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WILLIAM W. GUY and MARY B. P. GUY, their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 156, Section C, property of Woodfields, Inc., plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "GG", page 107, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeasterly side of Piney Woods Lane, joint front corner Lots 156 and 157, and running thence N. 33-28 E. 165 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots 156 and 157; thence N. 56-32 W. 90 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots 155 and 156; thence S. 33-28 W. 165 feet to an iron pin on the Northeasterly side of Piney Woods Lane, joint front corner Lots 155 and 156; thence along the Northeasterly side of Piney Woods Lane S. 56-32 E. 90 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

The grantees agree to assume and pay, according to its terms, that certain note and mortgage secured thereby heretofore executed and delivered by Marion L. Dickson in favor of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. dated September 14, 1955 and subsequently assigned to John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company, both the mortgage and assignment being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Mortgages Volume 652, at page 105, on which mortgage there is a principal balance of \$13,568.96 due as of October 1, 1956 plus accrued interest.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
