BEGINNING at a stone at the mouth of a branch which empties into the said Jamison's Mill Creek on the dividing line between the land hereby conveyed and the land that was reconveyed by John J. Campbell to William Reid on October 18, 1897, and running there e up the meanders of the said branch (above the road that leads across the mountain to David Lockhart's) to a stone at the head of said branch; thence along the line of the said William Reid land with the main leading hollow a Northeasterly course to the top of the mountain, to the original line of the William Reid plat, otherwise known as the "Earle old line"; thence with said O. P. Johnston by the said B.F.A. Prevette, and continuing thence to the line of the Pink Bellew land on top of Dockery Ridge; thence following the said Bellew line to the Durham land; thence following the Durham line Westward with the Cliffs to the L. Ballew line; thence Southward along the said L. Ballew line to Jamison's Mill Creek; thence down the said Jamison's Mill Creek, following the meanders thereof, to the beginning corner.

- (18) That tract in Glassy Mountain Township on Morgan's Creek of Middle Tyger River, containing 50 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands now or formerly belonging to James Center, Levi Brown, Charles Lindsay, N. M. Center, Levi Bowers, et al; being the same property described in a Deed to R. E. Johnston by Shadrack Sims, bearing date April 6, 1904, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Volume LLL, page 563.
- (19) That tract in Glassy Mountain Township on the waters of South Pacolet River and North Saluda River on Hogshead Knob on the Southwest of Big Hogback, containing 109 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a chestnut in the line of property now or formerly of Gilreath and running thence N. 10 W., 44.00 chains
