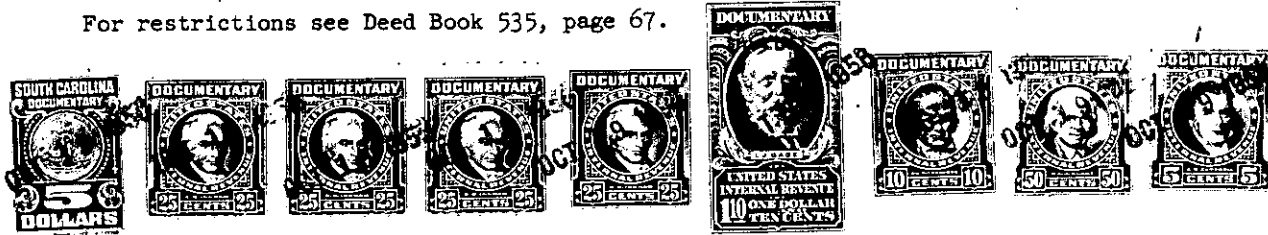
E. C. Haskell, Jr. and James H. Robinson, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being on the westerly side of Selwyn Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 11 on the plat of Timberlake as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book BB, page 185, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Selwyn Drive at a point 931.3 feet north of the northwesterly corner of the intersection of Selwyn Drive and Spartanburg Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, and running thence along the westerly side of Selwyn Drive N 5-44 W 22 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the westerly side of said Drive N 0-40 W 68.1 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11; thence along the joint line of said Lots N 88-25 W 248 feet to an iron pin; thence S 5-44 E 121.4 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12; thence along the joint line of said Lots N 84-16 E 240 feet to the point of beginning.
