to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James A. Boling, his heirs and assigns forever:

All those two certain lots of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lots # 273 and 274 on plat of property of Robert J. Edwards, recorded in Plat Book EE at Page 61, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds when described together:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Barbara Avenue, at the joint front corner of lots # 274 and 275, and running thence with the line of lot # 275, N. 47 W. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence with rear line of lots # 264, 263 and 262, S. 43 W. 200 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of lot # 270; thence with the rear line of lots # 270, 271 and 272, S. 47 E. 300 feet to an iron pin on Barbara Avenue; thence with the Northwestern side of Barbara Avenue, N. 43 E. 200 feet to the point of beginning.
