in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred DOLLARS,

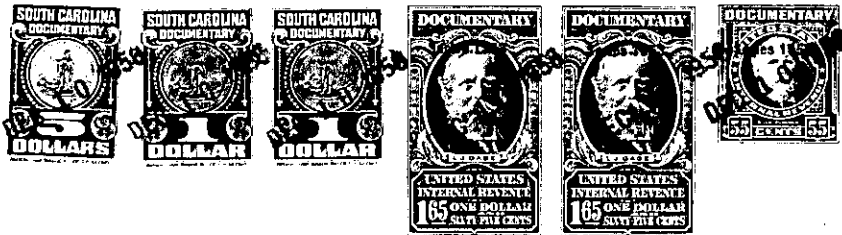
