WHEREAS, We, C. N. Wallance, Sr., Husband, and Margaret B. Wallace, Wife, each have an estate and an income; and,

WHEREAS, There are no children of our marriage, however, each of us was married prior to our marriage, and each has children of said prior marriages; and,

WHEREAS, Each of us desires his and her property to go to his and her said children respectively, upon our respective deaths, and to that end, each wishes to release and renounce his and her interest, dower and curtesy, and all like or similar rights in the property and estate of the other, and the object of the agreement is to effect the above and other purposes hereinafter mentioned.

Now, Therefore, Know All Men By These Presents, that we, the said C. N. Wallace, Sr., and Margaret B. Wallace, for and in consideration of the mutual and respective benefits accruing to us, and each of us, enter into the following agreement, to wit:

1. In accordance with the above stated purpose:

(a) The said C. N. Wallace, Sr., does hereby release and forever relinquish any and all rights and claims whatsoever - including the right of curtesy - that he has, or may have, in and to the property and estate of the said Margaret B. Wallace, arising or to arise by reason of their marital relationship; and,

(b) The said Margaret B. Wallace does hereby release and forever relinquish any and all rights and claims whatsoever - including the right of dower - that she has, or may have, in and to the property and estate of the said C. N. Wallace, Sr., arising or to arise by reason of their marital relationship.

Thus each is at liberty to do with his and her respective property as he and her pleases, respectively, and, among other ways, may dispose of his or her entire respective property and estate (s), by will and testament, or otherwise, in accordance solely with his or her good pleasure, or may die intestate,
