in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Thirty and No/100-----(\$330.00)-----DOLLARS, in the State aforesaid,

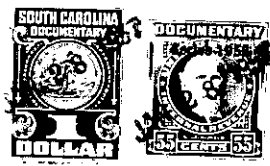
