A. MOSELEY, his heirs and assigns, forever:

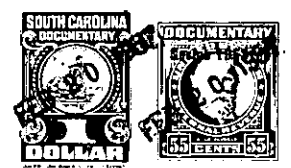
ALL my undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to ALL that lot of land situate on the East side of High Valley Boulevard, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot 33 on Plat I of Section I of Fresh Meadow Farms, made by Madison H. Woodward, Engineer, May 21, 1945, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "S", page 61, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of High Valley Boulevard, at joint front corner of Lots 32 and 33, and running thence with the line of Lot 32, N. 72-55 E., 300 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-05 E., 72.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 34, S. 72-55 W., 300 feet to an iron pin on the East side of High Valley Boulevard; thence along the East side of High Valley Boulevard, N. 17-05 W., 72.6 feet to the Beginning corner.
