to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Perry Abner Murrell, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that 1.85 acre tract of land in Greenville County, South Carolina near the Grove Road and on a County Road, shown on a plat of the property of A. B. Murrell made by C. O. Riddle, February, 1957 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin in the center of the County Road on the line of property now or formerly owned by Huguenin and Douglas and at the corner of a 2.89 acre tract which the grantor is conveying to W. C. Murrell and running thence with the approximate center of said road and with the property of Huguenin and Douglas, S. 46-36 E. 40.6 feet to a pin and S. 80-47 E. 152 feet to a pin; thence continuing with the line of Huguenin and Douglas, but leaving said road, S. 9-13 W. 164.1 feet to a pin at the corner of property of Fresh Meadow Farms, thence with the line of Fresh Meadow Farms, N. 80-47 W. 370 feet to a pin at a branch; thence with the branch as the line, along the line of property of Fresh Meadow Farms the following courses and distances along a traverse of said branch: N. 4-14 E. 67.4 feet, N. 52-06 W. 78.4 feet, N. 4-39 W. 77.3 feet and N. 36-42 W. 79.8 feet to a pin at the corner of the 2.89 acre tract; thence with the line of said tract S. 72-38 E. 338.4 feet to the beginning corner.
