in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Four Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$10,450.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Charles Leslie West, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the easterly side of Bear Grass Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 42 on the plat of Biltmore as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book Y, page 147, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Bear Grass Drive at a point 445.7 feet north of the northeasterly corner of the intersection of said Drive with Two Notch Road, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 41 and 42, and running thence with the joint line of said lots S 75-14 E 175.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N 24-46 E 76.15 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 42 and 43; thence with the joint line of said lots N 75-14 W 188.6 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Bear Grass Drive; thence with the easterly side of said Drive S 14-46 W 75 feet to the point of beginning.
