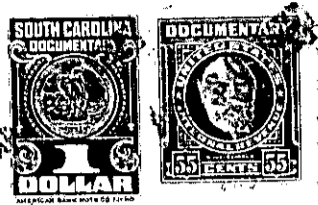

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina Containing Eleven and one-fourth (11.25) Acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of E. Barton, B. Duncan Cecil O. Heath, Grantor and Emma Hice and having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning in the center of the Greenville Road at E. Barton's corner and running thence N. 24-25 E. 331 feet to Iron Pipe; thence N. 28-50 W. 377.6 feet to a Spring; thence along branch as property line as follows: N. 62-15 E. 175 feet to point in center of branch; thence N. 6-40 E. 240 feet to stake; thence N. 20-20 E 232 feet to point in Branch; thence leaving branch S. 89-30 E. 446 feet to Iron pipe on Grantee's line; thence with a new line S. 9-25 W. 666 feet to stake in old road; thence S. 16-25 W. 397 feet to Axle in old road corner of Hice land; thence N. 74-30 W. 115.8 feet to iron pin; thence S. 54-30 W. 376.8 feet to point in center of Greenville Road (old Rutherford Road); thence N. 41-30 W. 61.5 feet to beginning corner.
