Know All Men by These Presents:

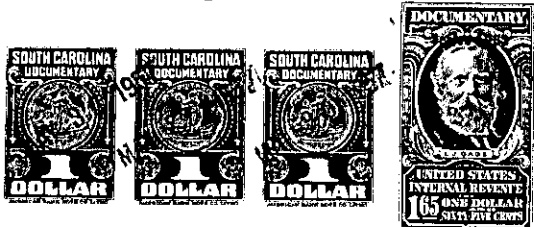

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James E. Burger, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that lot of land on the eastern side of Washington Avenue known as Lot #68, as shown by a plat of Grand View, made by Woodward Engineering Company, March, 1957, and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book KKat page 93, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Washington Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 67 and 68 and running thence along the eastern edge of Washington Avenue, N. 22 W., 61 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot #69; thence N. 68 E., 150 feet to a point on the side line of Lot #33; thence with the line of Lot #33, S. 22 E., 61 feet to a point on the line of Lot #67; thence with the line of Lot #67, S. 68 W., 150 feet to the point of beginning.
