Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Clarence C. Johnson, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 Dollar and division of property, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Johnson, his heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to the following described property:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the east side of the Old Buncombe Road about four miles north of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the eastern edge of the Old Buncombe Road, joint corner of the Cox property and property formerly owned by Mrs. Cary Johnson (marked on the plat hereinafter referred to as "property of J. H. Johnson", and running thence along the eastern edge of said Buncombe Road S. 7-0E & 202.7 feet to a point on the eastern edge of said Buncombe Road; thence S 83-10 E - 217.5 feet to a point; thence S 9-35 W along the eastern line of the Clarence Johnson property to a point, the southeastern corner of C larence C. Johnson property, said point being also on the Gillespie prop-erty; thence S. 81-15 E - 224.2 feet along the Gillespie line; thence N 10-0 E 396.8 feet to a point on Cox line; thence N 81-15 W - 501.2 feet to the point of beginning, according to a plat of property of J. H. Johnson recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book NN, at page 49, and being a portion of the Cary Johnson property coming to the grantee herein by virtue of a settlement of the Cary Johnson estate between grantor and grantee here-in. The deed to said property from The Peoples Bank of Fountain Inn to Mrs. Cary Johnson being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 53 at page 463.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises be- longing, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to war- rant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
