All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying, being and situate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 2 1/2 miles north-east of Princeton, South Carolina, on the southeast side of the public road leading from Princeton to Lebanon Church, containing Twenty-four and thirteen one-hundredths (24.13) Acres, more or less, being bounded on the northwest by other lands of the grantor named herein, with the aforesaid public road intervening; on the northeast by other lands of the grantor named herein; on the southeast by lands of the Greenwood Lumber Company and on the west and southwest by lands of Frank J.
