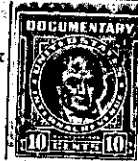

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
PAUL H. MOORE AND EUPHEMIA MOORE:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southwestern side of Pine Grove Road, in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 11 as shown on plat prepared by C. C. Jones, dated November, 1950, entitled "Pine Grove Heights" and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Pine Grove Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 10 and 11, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 10, S. 25-30 W. 158 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of Moody S. 64-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12; thence with the line of Lot No. 12 N. 25-30 E. 158 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Pine Grove Road; thence with the Southwestern side of Pine Grove Road N. 64-30 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of W. H. McCrary and Thelma Armstrong McCrary, dated October 14, 1950, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 421 at page 222.
