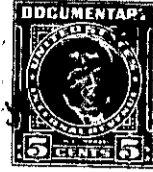

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in
County, State of South Carolina,

Township, Greenville

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the North
side of Gordon Street in Judson Mills No. 2 Village in the County of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as
LOT NO. 14 of Block "C" as shown on a plat of Judson Mills No. 2
Village made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers in March 1939, which plat is
recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "K", at
pages 1 and 2 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and
bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Gordon Street
at the joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15 of Block C and running thence
with line of Lot 15, North 9-14 West 168.7 feet to an iron pin; thence
with the line of Lot 17, South 80-46 West 56.2 feet to an iron pin;
thence with the line of Lot 13, South 9-14 East 178.1 feet to an iron
pin on the North side of Gordon Street; thence with the North side of
Gordon Street, North 71-13 East 57 feet to the beginning corner, being
the same lot conveyed by Judson Mill to Esther Holcombe, and by Esther
Holcombe to E. A. Whitfield, and by E. A. Whitfield to Gladys R. Scott,
and by Gladys R. Scott to Esther Holcombe.
