ASSIGNMENT OF RENT ORTH

THIS ASSIGNMENT, made this 9th day of August , 1955, between Horace M. Farr and Nannie G. Dollars (\$158.84), out of each monthly rent due and to become due under a certain lease by Assignor to Shell, dated August 9th

1955, of the following described premises, situated at Cedar Lane Road and Hunts Bridge Road
