WHEREAS, James S. Hunt and Harriette Hill Hunt entered into a marriage contract at Greenville, S. C., on the 17th day of January, 1953; and

WHEREAS, the parties have lived separate and apart since May 16, 1957, and each agrees with the other that there is no hope of reconciliation and that it is to their mutual advantage that they live separate and apart at all times in the future;

NOW, THEREFORE, this Agreement made and entered into by and between JAMES S. HUNT, hereinafter referred to as HUSBAND, and HARRIETTE HILL HUNT, hereinafter referred to as WIFE;

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H

The Husband and Wife above mentioned hereby agree as follows:

1. That the parties to this Agreement shall live separate and apart at all times in the future, each freed and discharged of any and all obligations arising out of their marriage contract.
2. That each of the parties may conduct themselves at all times in the future in the same manner as if no marriage contract had ever been entered into between the parties.
3. Both the Husband and Wife hereby release each to the other all interest they may have had in property owned by the other, and agree that all property owned or hereafter owned by the Husband shall be free from any claims of the wife, including right of Dower, and that all property owned by the Wife shall in like manner be free of any claim of the Husband.
5. It is further mutually understood and agreed that if either of the parties shall at any time apply for a divorce that the other will not contest the same; provided no allegations are made reflecting upon the moral character of the other.
