

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, In Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 175 of a subdivision known as Oak-Crest, Section 2, according to a plat prepared by C. C. Jones & Associates, January, 1955, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at pages 130 and 131, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Florida Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 174 and 175, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 22-06 W. 126.7 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 171; thence along the rear lines of Lots 171 and 170, N. 57-24 E. 76.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 176; thence along the line of that lot, S. 22-06 E. 140.8 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Florida Avenue; thence along the northern side of Florida Avenue, S. 67-54 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to Brown Inc. by George F. Townes, individually and as trustee by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 517, at Page 25.

It is understood and agreed that as a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay a certain note and mortgage in the original sum of \$8,250.00 executed by Brown, Inc. to First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville, S.
