KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that DRIVE-IN THEATRES OF S. C., INC., a corporation created and existing under the laws of South Carolina, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars paid to it by BELRUG MILLS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, a South Carolina corporation, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, released, and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, release and convey unto Belrug Mills of South Carolina, its successors and assigns, that piece, parcel or triangle of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the easternmost corner of the tract of land conveyed by this grantor to Belrug Mills, Inc., by deed dated August 31, 1955, which beginning point was at the time of said deed in the common line between this grantor and W. W. Pate; and running thence from said beginning point North 39 deg. 04 min. west 30 feet along the northeastern line of the tract of land conveyed in said deed of August 31, 1955, to a point; thence South 86 deg. 00 min. East 42.4 feet to a point in said common line or former common line of this grantor and W. W. Pate; thence South 49 deg. 00 min. West 30.99 feet to the beginning, being a triangular shaped tract of land. This deed is made subject to the restrictions contained in the deeds to Drive-In Theatres of S.C., Inc., conveying and including the tract of land conveyed by this deed, which restrictions are incorporated herein as if written out here in full.

Subject to Duke Power Company line rights.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said Belrug Mills of South Carolina, its successors and assigns
