FINAL DECREE

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard upon Motion of
the Plaintiff for Final Decree, and this Court being fully advised
in the premises, it is upon consideration thereof,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. That this Court has jurisdiction of the subject
matter hereof and the parties hereto.
2. That the Special Master's Report heretofore filed
in this cause be, and the same is hereby confirmed and ratified
in all respects.
3. That the equities of this cause are with the
Plaintiff and that the Defendant is guilty of extreme cruelty.
4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
the Plaintiff, NELL S. GRAYDON, be and she is hereby awarded the
custody and full control of the minor children of the parties,
Dovey Melvin Graydon, eighteen years old and Ronald David Graydon,
sixteen years old, and that the Defendant, WILLIAM L. GRAYDON, is
awarded reasonable rights of visitation to said children.
5. That the Plaintiff, NELL S. GRAYDON, be granted an
absolute divorce, a vinculo matrimonii from the Defendant, WILLIAM
L. GRAYDON, and the bonds of matrimony existing between them be and
the same are hereby dissolved.
6. That this Court retains jurisdiction of the parties
and the subject matter of this suit.
