CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

GEMMY FANVOST and G. L. FANVOST

did on the 3rd day of September, 1957, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is ...

THIRD: That the principal place of business is ...

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to buy and sell, hold, distribute and service auto parts and accessories, including and taking of all state and local taxes, licenses, purchases and sales, holdins, distribut, and incidental thereto.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is ... Dollars payable ...

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is ... of the par value of ... Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the ... day of ... 1957, at which a majority of the stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, ... as Vice-President, ... as Secretary, ... as Treasurer,

NINTH: That the proposed corporation is organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by the subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed by the subscribers, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State ...

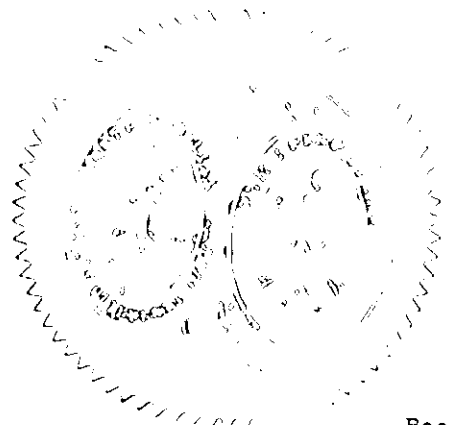
