

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Leslie & Shaw, Inc.
a corporation chartered under the laws of the State ofSouth Carolina
and having its principal place of business at
Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration
of the sum of Nine Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars,
to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Mrs. W. King
Thackston, her heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with buildings and improvements therson, lying and being on the southwesterly side of Laurens Road, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having according to a plat "Property of Leslie and Shaw, Inc.", made by C. C. Jones and Associates, dated July 31, 1956, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Laurens Road, joint corner of property now owned by Wheeler M. Thackston, and running thence along the Thackston line, S. 58-25 W. 427 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 31-35 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, corner of the property now or formerly of Triangle Construction Co., thence along Triangle Construction Company line, N. 58-25 E. 427 feet to an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Laurens Road, thence along the southwesterly side of Laurens Road, N. 31-35 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

The above tract contains 0.98 acres according to aforesaid plat by C. C. Jones and Associates and consists of a portion of lot #6, and all of lot #7, and the area in the rear thereof as shown on Plat of property of Elizabeth Beattie Smith, as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book H, page 99.
