(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Amelia N. Calhoun: All my one-half undivided interest in:

All that lot or parcel of land in the County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, beginning at an iron pin in the Greenville-Spartanburg County line and running with said line S. 1.0 W. about 1400 feet to a witnessed stake in stump; thence N. 84 W. 600 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1.0 E. about 1400 feet to an iron pin in the edge of road at the corner of old road leading East toward Landrum Reservoir; thence along road to Reservoir road in the general direction of S. 84 E. about 600 feet to an iron pin in the Greenville-Spartanburg line, the beginning corner, and containing 20 acres, more or less, and being a portion of the land deeded to Julian Calhoun by E. Inman, Master, March 23, 1936 and recorded in Book 173 at page 95, R. M. C. Office of Greenville County, South Carolina. This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor and Grantee by Deed of Julian Calhoun recorded in Deed Book 558, page 234 in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County.
