

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto said James Peden and Carolyn L. Peden,

for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them, his or her heirs and assigns, forever, in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Austin Township, known as lot # 17 in Hunters Acres near Simpsonville, and according to plat entitled Map of Hunters Acres by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, May 1952, it has the following courses and distances: Beginning at a point on the South side of Florence Drive at the joint fronts corners of lots number 19 and 20 and running along Florence Drive North 58-41 East 80 feet to an iron pin; thence along the joint line of lots number 18 and 19 South 31-26 East 186 feet to an iron pin; thence South 52-13 West 80.4 feet to an iron pin; thence North 31-26 West 195 feet to the beginning point.
