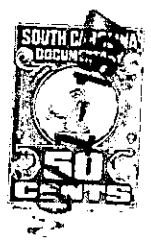
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Bobby Ray Batson, now more than Twenty years of age, of Greenville County, South Carolina, being enlisted in the Armed Services of the United States of America and subject to call for duty and be transferred without the said County and State, being desirous of appointing an Attorney in Fact for myself and on my behalf, of all matters in which I have, or may have, an interest, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint James C. Batson of said County and State, my true and lawful Attorney in Fact, with full power:

To have and to exercise full charge, control and management of all my properties and interests therein, real, personal and mixed, and of all such as I may acquire or may come to me, from time to time; to keep repaired, rent, lease, return for and keep all taxes paid; collect rentals and keep insured; with full power to pledge, mortgage, offer for sale, sell, transfer, assign, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any or all of such properties or interests therein, real, personal or mixed, on such terms and conditions and as often as he may deem for my best interests, all from time to time; and to execute good and sufficient deeds to convey, mortgages to obtain loans, bills of sale, contracts, and any other instruments and documents as may be necessary, proper and legal, to accomplish the foregoing, all in his discretion.

To invest and reinvest, from time to time, and as often as he may deem for my best interests, any of the moneys received and collected as rentals and income from my properties, any of the moneys realized from sale of my properties, or any moneys I have on deposit in any Bank, Banking Institution or Savings & Loan Association, to purchase or on purchase price and toward purchasing, other properties, real, personal or mixed, in said County and State; with full power to receive and accept good and sufficient deeds, bills of sale, contracts, and such other instruments and documents as may be necessary for accomplishment thereof.

To have and to exercise full charge and control of my finances and of any account I now carry, or may carry, in any Bank or Banking Institution or Savings & Loan Association; to execute vouchers in my behalf for such as may be properly payable to me by and from any source, endorse, collect and receive the proceeds of checks payable to my order by and from any source whatever for whatever account, and to give full discharge therefor; to deposit in my name and for my account any and all checks coming into his hands as such Attorney, and all moneys, bills of exchange, drafts, promissory Notes and other securities for money payable to or belonging to me, and for that purpose to sign my name and endorse same for deposit or collection, and from time to time withdraw any moneys or otherwise, deposited with said depositories and for that purpose to draw checks in my name and all otherwise as required by depository.



To ask, demand, sue for, levy, collect, recover and receive any and all moneys, claims, debts, rents, good, wares, dues, accounts and other demands, which are, or shall be, due, owing and payable to me or detained from me; to give and execute proper and sufficient receipts, acquittances and discharges; to compromise or adjust any claim, debt, or otherwise in which I may have an interest; to employ and pay legal aid.

To pay any just and legal debt, claim, demand, accounts, dues or liabilities of any kind, which are or shall be owing or payable by me; to receive and accept proper and sufficient receipts and discharges.

To contract, to make, execute and deliver, and where necessary and proper to seal any contract, document or instrument, necessary, proper and legal; to pay all costs, charges and expenses to carry out the above.

To do all at all times in his discretion for my best interests.

Giving and granting unto my said Attorney in Fact, by these presents, full power and authority in and about the premises, and authorizing him to do and perform all necessary acts and things in the execution of the foregoing; and I do expressly declare that the powers herein granted to my said Attorney in Fact, shall not be construed as limited to those matters hereinabove specifically set forth, but rather shall be construed to broadly include and embrace full and unlimited power and authority to do and perform on my behalf and in my place and stead and with equal validity, any and all other lawful acts or things which I
