"All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the building and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of Old Farm Lane, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 100 on plat of Woodfields, made by C. C. Jones, Surveyor, October, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "S", at pages 112 and 113, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Old Farm Lane at the joint front corner of Lots 99 and 100, and running thence along the line of Lot 99, N. 33-17 E., 112.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 98, N. 42-17 E., 12 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 105, S. 51-26 E. 127.1 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Milford Lane; thence along the West side of Milford Lane, S. 36-11 W., 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Milford Lane and Old Farm Lane (the chord being S. 76-12 W., 36 feet) to an iron pin on the North side of Old Farm Lane; thence with the North side of Old Farm Lane, N. 65-42 W., 102.7 feet to the beginning corner.
