THIS INDENTURE, made by and between EASTERN ENGRAVING COMPANY, INC., a corporation organized according to the laws of the State of Rhode Island, and licensed to do business in the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called "Assignor", and CHARLOTTE TEXTILE ENGRAVERS, INC., a North Carolina corporation, hereinafter called the "Assignee";

W I T N E S S E T H:

That in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations paid by the Assignee to the Assignor, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the Assignor, the Assignor hereby assigns unto the Assignee a certain lease agreement dated May 9, 1955, and existing between Walter W. Goldsmith and Henry P. Willimon as Lessor and Eastern Engraving Company, Inc., a corporation, as Lessee, covering premises known as 100 Guess Street in Greenville, South Carolina, together with the premises therein described, and the buildings thereon, with the appurtenances.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the Assignee, Charlotte Textile Engravers, Inc., its successors and assigns, from the 21st day of October, 1957, for all the rest of the term of five years mentioned in the said lease, subject to the rents, covenants, conditions and provisions therein also mentioned.

And the Assignor hereby covenants that the said assigned premises are free from encumbrances.
