CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

CORA CHRISTOPHER, HUGH TINSLEY and HERMAN E. COX

did on the 21st day of December, 19 57, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is REAL ESTATE INVESTMENTS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to purchase, sell, own, rent, manage, improve and otherwise deal in real estate and personal property of any and all kinds and description.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Three Thousand Five Hundred (\$3,500.00)- Dollars payable in cash.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Thirty-five (35) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)----- Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 18th day of December, 19 57, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Hugh Tinsley, Cora Christopher, John Bobst, Louise Scott, Charles Mattox, John Ward, Maxwell Patton, Herman E. Cox, Franky Coward, Peggy Kilpatrick, Frank Pierce, Douglas Lee, W. E. Riddle, Jr., Clarence Odom, James D. Gowan, James Baker and Herbert L. Stukes.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Cora Christopher ; as Vice-President, Maxwell Patton ; as Secretary, Louise Scott ; as Treasurer, Hugh Tinsley

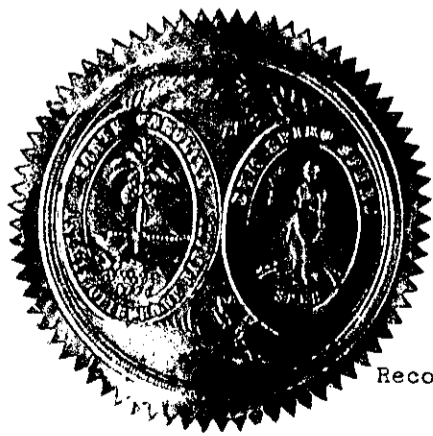
NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
