WHEREAS, Mr. Hampton Sheppard of Greenville, South Carolina is the owner of forty shares of the capital stock in the firm of Watkins, Arnold & Sheppard, Mortuary, a South Carolina Corporation of Greenville, South Carolina, and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Sheppard is desirous of selling one-half of his interest to Mr. J. W. Woods of Route 1, Mountain Inn, South Carolina, and whereas, the conditions precedent to sale have been met or waived by the original stockholders.

KNOW ALL MEN by these presents, that I, Hampton Sheppard, in consideration of one thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$1,750.00), to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby, set, assign, and transfer, and sell all of my right, title and interest in twenty (20) shares of stock being the same numbers assigned to me in the first issue of stock, to Mr. J. W. Woods, his heirs and assigns, upon the following terms and conditions:

No. 1

1. That the sum of \$350.00 be paid at the time of the signing of this agreement and the balance of \$1400.00 payable at the rate of \$50.00 per month commencing the 1st day of March, 1958, and each month thereafter until paid in full with interest at the rate of three percent (3%) per annum, the payment to be applied first to interest and then to principal, with the privilege of accelerating the payments.

2. That the said shares will be retained as security for the balance due, until paid in full, and transferred in the name of the buyer at that time, with the understanding that the buyer shall have all equitable control arising by reason of the ownership thereof including the dividends declared if any.
