do hereby make, constitute and appoint my Brother, James E Smith of Greenville, South Carolina,  
as my attorney-in-fact, for the following purposes only: To be able to act in my behalf in the divorce suit filed by Mary Lee Bolt Smith against me in Greenville, South Carolina. The said James E Smith shall have the power to retain legal counsel, to pay all cost incident to the suit, and to make all settlements as to the division of the marital property. The said James E Smith shall have the power to sign all instruments, contracts, releases, or other papers incident to this suit. It is understood that this suit may be dismissed without a final judgement being rendered, if this occurs the said James E Smith shall have the same powers in any other suit which may occur between the parties.

And my said attorney-in-fact is hereby empowered to do any other act or thing necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the purposes set forth above, and I hereby ratify and confirm all that my said attorney shall do in pursuance thereof.
